- A medical certificate of no contradictions for studying translated into English or Polish by a sworn translator
- Health insurance documentation (against sickness and accidents for the period of staying in Poland)

Note! In case the candidate requires a visa to stay and study on the territory of European Union, student should apply for selected program adequately earlier, so that decision concerning visa issuance is made before the semester starts.
